Behaviorists Needed

Valley Mountain Regional Center (VMRC) is recruiting behaviorists to be vendored to provide services to persons with developmental disabilities in VMRC's 5-county catchment area: Amador, Calaveras, San Joaquin, Stanislaus, and Tuolumne Counties.

Behaviorists can be vendored in one of three categories which vary based on required qualifications as follows:

- Adaptive Skills Trainer (service code 605):
 - Possess a Master's Degree in one of the following: education, psychology, counseling, nursing, social work, applied behavior analysis, behavioral medicine, speech and language, or rehabilitation; *and*
 - Have at least one year of experience in the design and implementation of adaptive skills training plans.
- Behavior Analyst (service code 612):
 - Certification by the national Behavior Analyst Certification Board as a Board Certified Behavior Analyst.
- Behavior Management Consultant (service code 620):
 - Completion of 12 semester units in applied behavior analysis, *and*
 - 2 years experience designing and implementing behavior modification intervention services, *and*
 - License as a Marriage and Family Therapist pursuant to Business and Professions Code, Section 4980 through 4984.7, *or*
 - License as a Psychologist from the Medical Board of California or Psychology Examining Board, *or*
 - License as a Clinical Social Worker pursuant to Business and Professions Code, Sections 4996 through 4998.7.

Applicants may employ Associate Behavior Analysts or Behavior Management Assistants to provide services under the Behavior Analyst or Behavior Management Consultant's supervision; however, a lower rate will be assigned in that case.

- Associate Behavior Analyst (service code 613):
 - Certification by the national Behavior Analyst Certification Board as a Board Certified Associate Behavior Analyst



- Behavior Management Assistant (service code 615):
- Possesses a Bachelor of Arts or Science Degree *and either*
 - 12 semester units in applied behavior analysis and one year of experience in designing and/or implementing behavior modification intervention services, *or*
 - 2 years experience in designing and/or implementing behavior modification intervention services
- Or*
- Is registered as a Psychological Assistant of a psychologist by the Medical Board of California or Psychology Examining Board, or
 - Is registered as an Associate Licensed Clinical Social Worker pursuant to Business and Professions Code, Section 4996.18.

Service Location: Services are to be provided in the family's home.

Rate of Compensation: Varies based upon the vendor category for which applicant qualifies.

The current rates are:

Adaptive Skills Trainer:	\$41.20 per hour*
Behavior Analyst:	\$45.00 per hour*
Behavior Management Consultant:	\$50.87 per hour*

*Please note that, although this is the current rate, the State of California Legislature has initiated a 3% payment discount for all vendors effective 2/1/09 through at least 6/30/10.
