1. Review and Approval of the Meeting Agenda:

M/S/C (BOWE/HEINZ) to approve the agenda.

M/S/C (BOWE) to approve the Finance & Personnel Committee minutes of June 6, 2018

Following discussion regarding the Contract Summary for Central Valley Training Center-Stockton, Tom Bowe amended his motion:

M/S/C (BOWE/HEINZ) to approve the minutes, noting Central Valley Training Center-Stockton is not a new program.

2. <u>Public Comment</u>:

There was no public comment this month.

3. Fiscal Department Update:

Acceptance of Contract Status Report through June 2018:

Melissa presented the committee with a new format of the Contract Status Report.

Revenue year-to-date is \$197,740,598. Cash receivables total \$30,010,313. Melissa pointed out there still are two months' worth of retirement and POS Disparities and Mental Health grants to come out of last year's budget. The remaining balance of CPP is due to our consultant who has not yet put in all her invoices.

POS expenditures for the year total \$179,361,053, with a budget of \$181,896,226. There will be some late invoices for POS, and it is anticipated the remaining \$2,649,032 will be depleted. The prior year-to-date stands at \$166,268,260.

Elizabeth requested an additional column for the difference between what has been spent vs. budget.

Operations expenditures year-to-date total \$28,990,592 with a budget of \$30,275,505. The prior year to date stands at \$29,979,952. Late bills are anticipated.

M/S/C (BOWE/HEINZ) to accept the CSR as presented.

Review of Contracts over \$250,000:

Melissa reviewed the contracts over \$250,000 with committee members. There was a correction to the contract for Psychiatric Centers at San Diego.

Elizabeth requested an additional information for percentages of money spent vs. budget for each contract. Tom Bowe suggested showing the previous and the new rates when amendments are presented. Melissa will follow up with Vendorization to ask why there is a difference in contract terms.

M/S/C (BOWE/HEINZ) to accept all contracts as presented. There was an abstention from Connie Uychutin.

Human Resources Update:

Human Resources Report:

Bud Mullanix, Human Resources Director, presented statistics for the past fiscal year. There was a total of 331 employees at the end of fiscal year 2017-18. There were 48 new hires, and 33 employees were termed. The growth rate is at 3.4%, with a turnover rate of 10.1%. The average tenure of employees is 9 years. Following a question from Tom, Bud said he had spoken to some of the other Human Resources Directors, and VMRC's statistics are in line with other regional centers.

Recruiting/Staffing Report:

Four positions were filled in July, two Service Coordinators, an Assistant Director, and a Senior Accountant, and this will improve next month's figures. Currently HR has three Service Coordinator positions to backfill, an Accountant position, and a Manager position, the latter two openings were created following staff member promotions.

Historically it has been difficult to fill Service Coordinator positions in the San Andreas office, but recently there were multiple applications. The Summer Intern has worked out well, and she has now become a regular full time Service Coordinator.

Bud said the three big items that HR is currently working on are the Union Contract, management training, and performance reviews.
