QA QUICK TIP: COVID-19 SIR REPORTING REQUIRED

To identify high risk events and incident trends related to the COVID-19 pandemic and to swiftly implement risk mitigation activities, DDS is directing regional centers <u>and all providers</u> to complete an SIR for any of the following events:

- 1. An individual has had direct contact with any person who has tested positive for COVID-19, including provider staff, family, and other individuals*;
- 2. An individual is exhibiting COVID-19 SYMPTOMS AND HAS VISITED A HOSPITAL FOR ANY RELATED SYMPTOMS OR HAS BEEN TESTED FOR covid-19;
- 3. An individual was recommended to be tested for COVID-19;
- 4. An individual tested positive for Covid-19; or,
- 5. An individual is exhibiting covid-19 SYMPTOMS AND WAS INSTRUCTED TO QUARANTINE.

*If the provider or their staff or family fall into one of the above categories, notify your QA Liaison and Nicole Weiss, Assistant Director-Case Management at nweiss@vmrc.net. If you do not know who your Liaison is, contact Kioti Fleming, Senior Office Technician at 209-955 3287 or kfleming@vmrc.net.

- COVID-19 Reporting is done under the category of "Other" and please specify "COVID-19 Related."
