- iii. Census is less than expected for Regional Center consumers. Usually see a decrease in funding, but instead saw and increase in funding.
- iv. Budget points discussed with senate:
  - 1. Employment for IDD was talking point.
  - 2. Equitable rate adjustments due to minimum wage.
  - 3. Suspension of family cost program fees
  - 4. Giving regional centers money for Health and Safety waivers.
  - 5. Participant directed services- possibly may be permanent.
  - 6. Permanent remote assessments
  - 7. SLS for those that live with families.
  - 8. 8.8% Rate increase permanent not to sunset discussions still happening.
  - 9. Provisions for out of state placements.
  - 10. Case loads funding to come into compliance.
