Requirements

To participate, the Partners program requires:

- A commitment to attend all eight sessions. Each session includes both Saturday and Sunday
- An interest in learning and practicing new skills in a comfortable and safe environment
- A desire to build and strengthen a network of people from diverse cultural backgrounds and life experiences
- A willingness to learn from national and state experts who share our vision and values
- Complete an application, be available for interview if advance in the selection process
- Complete assignments/activities on time

Who can apply?

The program is designed for parents/legal guardians of young children with developmental disabilities and adults with developmental disabilities. You can apply even if you do not know English.
